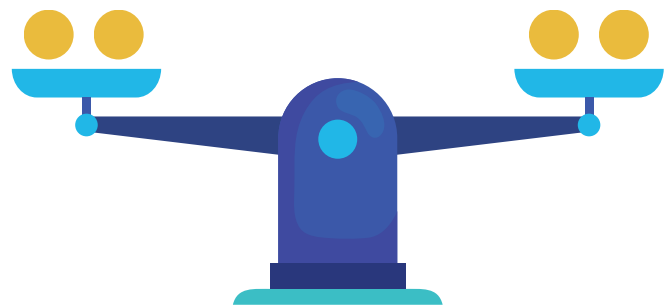

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# 2ND GRADE MATH RESEARCH STUDY!

WestEd is partnering with the University of Notre Dame to evaluate ICUE (Improving Children's Understanding of Equivalence) Online. These supplementary, online math activities focus on improving 2nd grade students' understanding of mathematical equivalence.

Children's formal understanding of mathematical equivalence in elementary school predicts their algebra readiness in middle school. These supplementary materials complement any existing mathematics curriculum!

Previous research suggests that children who use ICUE achieve meaningful improvements in their understanding of mathematics. This study is funded by the US Department of Education.
