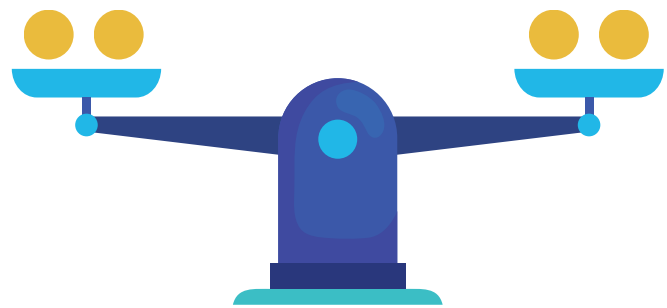


JOIN OUR

This study explores the impacts on student learning when using different online math activities. The goal of this study is to improve children's formal understanding of mathematical equivalence. Their understanding in elementary school predicts their algebra readiness in middle school.

WHO

- 2nd Grade Math Teachers

WHEN

- 2024-25 School Year

STUDY INFORMATION

- Teachers will use up to 32 online math lessons over 16 weeks (2 15-minute lessons per week).
- All teachers will attend an online teacher training; complete a background survey, administer study forms and assessments; complete weekly online logs, and complete a post-study survey.
- Teachers will be randomly assigned to use one of two different sets of online math activities.
- Teachers must have at least one year of prior experience teaching 2nd grade math.
- Participating classrooms will need 1-to-1 device access or the ability for students to complete online, in-class activities independently.
